



## Blog Content Guidelines For Urantiabook.org

### I. Policy

It is the purpose for these blog guidelines of UrantiaBook.org to provide a positive interactive community platform that will inform site visitors about ongoing Urantian inspiration and scholarship. It is the intention for the blogs at Urantiabook.org to:

- A. Be a thought provoking and inspirational hub for site visitors and students of The Urantia Book.
- B. Provide readers with a forum to share the teachings of The Urantia Book.
- C. Engage and inspire those who visit the site.
- D. Serve as a conduit of discovery for various interpretations of The Urantia Book.

### II. Content Guidelines

Acceptable blog content for publication on Urantiabook.org shall:

- A. Relate to The Urantia Book and its community of readers.
- B. Be respectful of the individual and/or group (past or present), race, political party, government, religion or creed.
- C. Contain information and constructive opinions related to the vision and goals of The Urantia Book Fellowship.
- D. Promote content that is commensurate with the teachings of The Urantia Book and is relevant to visitors and students of The Urantia Book.

- E. Allow for civil and constructive discussion.
- F. Include inspiring and/or thought provoking content.
- G. Express tact and forgiving tolerance.

### **III. Content Oversight**

- A. An Editorial Board appointed by the Executive Committee, currently comprised of The Urantia Book Fellowship Administrator, Web-Master and Executive Staff, will be responsible for recruiting and overseeing content on the blogs at UrantiaBook.org. If blog content is deemed questionable, it will be disabled pending review by the Editorial Board. After review, if the blog is deemed acceptable according to the content guidelines above, it will be restored. If the Editorial Board determines the blog does not meet the guidelines, the blog will be removed permanently. Repeated violations of the guidelines may result in the removal of the blog after reasonable attempts have been made to communicate these concerns to the blogger. The Editorial Board reserves the right to disable posts, comments, and users pending review.
- B. Challenges to the ruling of the Editorial Board may be appealed to the Fellowship Officers.
