**TDA**: Due to miscommunications, the TDA did not convene this past summer. Plans are currently being favorably discussed to re-convene during IC'11.

Database Audit: This past summer we accepted a mission to call everyone in the Fellowship database just to say hello. This then evolved into an audit of our FMS database. With committee members acting as team leaders, volunteers will be auditing 4,672 out of almost 10,000 records. (4,672 represents the records in the US & Canada having telephone numbers.)

The Audit has begun and currently we have distributed approx. 500 names, and have completed \_\_\_\_\_.

In addition, we are assembling a 2<sup>nd</sup> Milers Missions. These folks are tasked with following through on calls to Urantians, whom the auditors identified as needing just "a little more".

**Special Events:** In joint participation with Outreach & Educations, Membership is organizing a task force representative of the best ideas available for assisting Local Societies in reinvigorating their membership to inspirer local activity and growth in readership and study groups. Our first project will be Connecticut.
