Dear Miss George:

Your letter of July 26, 1971, addressed to Urantia Brotherhood Corp. and enclosing a check in the amount of \$154.70, and your letter of August 2, 1971, addressed to me and enclosing a check in the amount of \$100.00, are both at hand.

I note your report (in your letter of August 2) of the number of long distance telephone calls that you -- which I understand to be: the Urantian School of Research -- have been receiving from strangers in various large cities east of Chicago seeking copies of the URANTIA Book. I further note that, in response to these calls, Books have been sent from a dealer in your area to New York City.

As I view the situation, the telephone calls which you have described strongly suggest that the Urantian School of Research has been continuing its active and extensive publicizing of the URANTIA Book and its teachings -- as though the Book were either a product of, or in some direct and official way connected with, the Urantian School of Research.

Further, as I believe, this is being done by the distribution of pamphlets and brochures which paraphrase, or even directly copy, passages from the Book - without, of course, any authorization to do so from the URANTIA Foundation, the copyright owner.

Your expression of interest in making the URANTIA Book available throughout the country by way of placing gift books in libraries is surprising -- in view of the fact that we have been doing precisely this for a number of years. I must confess that it is difficult for me to understand how you could have failed to be aware of this. Similarly, I would have thought that you would have known that we have a great many dealers, in the East as well as in other parts of the country, who handle the URANTIA Book.

Under all the circumstances, and since formal notice has been sent to Mr. King, on behalf of the URANTIA Foundation, demanding discontinuance of the unauthorized use of the name URANTIAN (in the name "Urantian School of Research") as well as a termination of all copyright infringements, we certainly cannot see our way clear to furnish you any more copies of the URANTIA Book.

I return to you herewith, therefore, your check in the amount of \$134.70 and your more recent additional check in the amount of \$100.00.
