Dear Berkeley:

As per our recent telephone conversation, please find enclosed a copy of the script for the multimedia of "A History of the URANTIA Movement". This version of the script was given to me in June, 1988 by Dan Massey, then chairman of the Publications Committee. Dan told me at the time that this version of the script is the most up to date. Unless there have been additional revisions of which I am unaware, this version of the script is the one you and your associates will be revising in the coming months.

As the newly appointed Liaison for the Publications Committee, it seemed to me that it would be useful to summarize the historical status of "A History of the URANTIA Movement" and to consider some details associated with the revision of the script. The multimedia production "A History of the URANTIA Movement" is a "workfor-hire" created at the direction of the Executive Committee by the Publications Committee of URANTIA Brotherhood. Since its creation, the production has been a work in progress and has been revised. The Executive Committee and/or the officers of URANTIA Brotherhood have authorized each showing of the production as part of an ongoing evaluation process. The production has not been publicly distributed.

The revision of this production which you and your associates are undertaking is being done under the auspices of the Publications Committee of URANTIA Brotherhood. While you and your associates may, of course, use the script in the revision process, it should not be reproduced or distributed outside of the group working on the revisions. Once you and your associates have completed working on the revision, it is requested that you either return to URANTIA Brotherhood office, the copy of the script enclosed along with any other copies made or destroy them and so notify the Brotherhood.
