Thank you for your letter of June 5, 1961, returning a signed copy of the letter constituting an amendment to Article 6 of our contract concerning publication of the French translation of THE URANTIA BOOK. This letter will also serve to give our written approval of the translation of Parts 1, 2 and 3 of the English text and to authorize its printing. You will recall that paragraph 4 of the agreement calls for the foregoing approval and authorization and also specifies that you will let us have an English translation of the contract with the printer promptly after signing it. Similarly, you will promptly send us an English translation of the contract with the publisher.
