We herewith submit the following proposition for your consideration:

Composition

We are to set the type from your typewritten or reprint copy in 11 on 12 point Linotype Old Style No. 7 we have at our Crawfordsville, Indiana plant, in accordance with sample pages prepared by our design department and submitted herewith. Page size to be 30 x 52-1/2 picas overall including running head with folio. The prices quoted below include storage and insurance on your plates while they are in our possession.

The price quoted does not, unless otherwise stated, include the editing of copy. If you wish us to edit copy, we will do so at an additional charge, according to the amount of work involved.

All changes made in proofs, either in wording or style, will be charged additional to the price quoted, at \$3.10 per hour for hand composition, \$3.65 per hour for Linotype composition, \_\_\_\_\_ per hour for Monotype keyboard composition and \_\_\_\_\_ per hour for Monotype caster composition. Such alterations will be indicated by a notice attached to the proof altered when forwarded for O. K. This notice will show exact amount of chargeable alterations in hours and tenths of an hour. It is understood and agreed that any objection as to the amount of this chargeable time must be made within 10 days from date of said notice, otherwise objection will be waived.

(These stereotypes will give as good a reproduction and as long life as wax mold electrotypes.)

The above price does not include the manufacture of engravings, electrotypes, etc., unless so stated. In either case, or in case engravings, electrotypes, etc., are furnished, any necessary repairing, trimming, mortising, anchoring, special proving or similar work will be billed as an extra charge at current market rates. It is understood and agreed that all lithographic negatives, positives and plates, or gravure negatives, positives and cylinders made by us shall remain the property of R. R. Donnelley & Sons Co. for your use only.

Storage on printed matter will be charged if delivery is not taken 30 days after completion.

## **Delivery**

The present paper describes some of the more important features of the new system of navigation which has been developed by the U.S. Bureau of Fisheries for use in the Pacific Northwest. The system is based upon the use of radio signals transmitted from fixed stations to determine the position of a ship at sea. The signals are transmitted in the form of short pulses of radio waves, and the time required for the signal to travel from the station to the ship is used to calculate the distance between the two. The system also includes a means of determining the direction of the ship relative to the station.
