### PAGE *lx* COMPARISONS - 1955 and 1967

Page *lx* is important because it was a companion page that was printed side by side with page 3 in the same printing signature. We discovered it had not been changed. So the alterations were apparently strictly confined to areas that contained supposed “copying errors.” This shows a special degree of sensitivity to the original plates, because it would have been simpler to replace the entire plate. Unfortunately however, the alterations fatally compromised the integrity of the plates, which were a key portion of the Substantive Estate. This is probably why all of the original plates were ordered destroyed a couple of years later.
